### 1.

**To provide our law makers the necessary evidence to help them in making better judgments and decisions of laws in our health care system concerning the unquestionable need of mental and health care to child sexual abuse survivors, to include the disorders and ailments associated with and resulting from the trauma of the abuse.**

**1.**

**To be locally and community involved, by adopting a child's service, such as a children's group home, raising funds to help provide for necessities of the children, sponsoring Christmas parties and/or fall festivals, be a friend, big brother or big sister by visiting, teaching and interacting with the children.**

**2.**

**To open and have operational clinical resource centers for victims and survivors of child sexual abuse and their families and supporters in communities across the nation. These centers provisions will include mental health care and recovery resources for victims and survivors, support and resources for the families and supporters of the survivors, education in prevention and awareness of child sexual abuse, and a strong community and local business involvement. Each center will be under the oversight and management of its State and Chapter Directors, while being locally operated and managed by community professionals and volunteers with expert knowledge and education of child sexual abuse and recovery. **cost of such services to a donation amount or no cost at all to the clients, we will encourage and invite professionals to offer their expertise free of charge, as a gift of giving back to their own community, receiving the rewards of children's safety, mental stability and joint community efforts as their pay.**

**United Survivors, Inc. Board of Directors will take the position of oversight, close scrutiny, and involvement to insure proper operations of each center. With the help of the Board, each State will have the responsibility of providing the funding for operational overhead costs, through government grants and funds, local and state fund raisers, community donations and contributions, and funds raised through its participation of Organizational National Events.**
